### **Efforts made for Contribution towards Environment Protection**

1. Rain water harvesting is not yet done in the school premises but it is proposed and will be materialized very soon as we also are aware that lots of fresh rain water is wasted.
2. Proper disposal of waste is done, the Municipality Van comes every alternative day to collect the waste from the school. Electrical waste is collected and disposed separately. Waste is segregated in Biodegradable and non-biodegradable and then disposed accordingly.
3. School is using LED bulbs and tube lights exclusively in the school premises. School electricity consumption is minimized as classes are airy, and with full of natural light.
4. School campus has lush green lawn and grounds with trees and plants. School also holds a plantation drive where students and residents of nearby colony plant trees. School also runs a Campaign- “Each One –Plant One” where students plant trees and nurture them.
5. School is not using solar energy at present but there is a proposal for solar panels and lights.
6. School promotes Environment Conservation and also holds Go Green Rally, Anti Cracker Rally and Each One-Plant One Campaign to maintain quality air.

In this respect, environment cleanliness is the prime concern and students are briefed regularly in this respect.

### **INNOVATIVE PRACTICES IN THE SCHOOL**

1. School organizes workshops, training sessions for the three main pillars of education system – Students, Teachers and Parents.

2. Latest pedagogical approaches are adopted to teach the students.
3. Lots of School Based Training Programmes are organized to train teachers.
4. Teachers attend Capacity Building Programmes organized by CBSE.
5. Various workshops are organized for teachers on Bloom's Taxonomy & Gardeners' Theory of Multiple Intelligences.
6. Experiential learning is promoted.
7. School has beautiful Activity Room, Science Lab, Maths Lab and Computer Lab.
8. Project Exhibition is displayed in school every year by students.
9. The school agrees in the principle that inclusion of all children in mainstream schooling will help to develop an inclusive society.
10. After assembly there is a period for 10 minutes of meditation for all the students.
11. All efforts are made to imbibe high moral values & sterling human qualities in the students.
12. School organizes frequent workshops on Life Skills for Students, Teachers and Parents.
13. For parents various workshops are organized on the topics Positive Parenting & Conscious Parenting.
14. Principal and Teachers also attended workshops on Life Skills conducted by CBSE.
15. In accordance with CBSE norms related to mainstreaming of Health and Physical Education school has designed the time table accordingly. By regular Yoga, PT Sessions and Sports students develop the knowledge, understanding and skills to support them to be resilient, to develop a strong sense of self esteem and to build satisfying relationships.
16. School has taken care of all safety and security measures. Mock drills for evacuation are conducted frequently. Evacuation plans are displayed on all floors, fire extinguishers are checked and refilled. 24 hours security is there in school premises. Attendants are always there in Buses for students on board.
17. School is well equipped with Computer lab and smart classes also.
18. School has a vast lush green playground with big shady plants. School promotes "Each One Plant One" campaign and organizes "Go Green Rally" to create awareness to save environment amongst the students and the local residents.
19. School organizes Human Unity & Peace Rally every year.
20. School also launches "Each One Teach One" Campaign every year when students teach one illiterate person.
21. Roti Bank activity is organized twice a month to develop the habit of sharing and caring in children. Children bring fresh Roti and vegetable from home to be distributed to under privileged people of society.

### **PTA Activities :**

The Teacher Representative and Parent Representative from each class are the members of the PTA. PTA Meetings are scheduled quarterly in which the Agenda points are discussed, also the Parent Representatives share their suggestions on behalf of the complete class and discuss on the

platform. In case of any problem the action taken report is also read and what all actions are taken are briefed by the Principal to the parents in the next PTA meet.

Positive reports given by parents motivate the teachers. They also give valuable suggestions to run the school.
